cartels are prohibited per se In EU, cartels are prohibited subject to specific exemptions Although, prohibiting cartels by law does not forestall illegal collusion from existing, the illegal cartels are found to be less stable than the legal ones since illegal contracts cannot be enforced (Neumann, 1995)
