Leighton became one of Alberta's earliest artists to explore the Rockies in depth, first with the Trail Riders of the Canadian Rockiesxiii (founded by his Canadian boss, John Murray Gibbon, and on his invitation) where he traveled to McArthur Pass via Marble Canyon and Goodsir Plateau in 1925 and Mt Assiniboine via Allenby Creek in 1927
